As statements of intent go, Tankoa's first vacht, the 69.4-metre Suerte, is formidable. The brief for the interior design team of Francesco Paszkowski and Margherita Casprini was for something modern and yet warm, and that has certainly been delivered. The brushed teak woodwork is light and welcoming, but it's the use of spaces throughout that really catches the eye - the main salon is divided into a relaxed 'winter garden' area aft, a sociable

media area (left), and a formal dining space. Throughout, artworks and art photographs add a personal flavour. Also on the main salon are three VIPs and two twin guest cabins, with a huge master on the deck above. The owner's deck has some stellar features, including a hot-tub forward of the suite, a relaxing lounge, and an alfresco dining area. Sanlorenzo's first explorer

When you create your first explorer yacht, you need a decent proving ground. Sanlorenzo has found just that for Moka, the yard's first 460Exp, which left Viareggio on her maiden voyage to Florida, 5,600 cruising miles away. Despite some close encounters with winter Atlantic depressions, the yacht came through with not even the hint of a drama, and she is now off cruising warmer climes with her owner.
