Another announcement at the Monaco Yacht Show came from Tankoa Yachts which revealed the new S621 superyacht concept the Genoa-based boutique yard claims raises the bar to a whole new level in terms of elegance and living space. A joint project with the well-regarded Francesco Paszkowski Design Studio, the Tankoa S621 is inspired by M/Y 69m Suerte and Tankoa S501, the yard's first two offerings, but layers in distinctive features of its own to the mix for a unique result. The vessel's stern and bow lines, for instance, are a nod to the

Tankoa S501 with the superstructure reminiscent of Suerte. That said, the 62-metre's windows are larger to deliver brighter interiors while its superstructure is ultra-clean and severe. An extended stern helps guarantee very roomy, harmonious volumes akin to those of a bigger craft too with amenities that include an enormous beach club, a chic lounge and sublime infinity pool really does feel infinite thanks to a vanishing edge.
